

Day 1: Arrive in Istanbul

- Overnight in Çanakkale and visit the emotionally charged 1915 ANZAC war grounds and memorials.


- Explore the vibrant city of Çanakkale with its unique blend of modern and historical elements.

- Explore the ancient city of Troy, known for the legendary Trojan War, and visit its captivating museum.


- Drive to Ayvalik, a charming town on the Aegean coast.

- Enjoy the breathtaking views of Ayvalik and experience the laid-back coastal life against the backdrop of the Greek island of Lesbos.






Clockwise, Anzac Cove, Lone Pine Cemetery, fallen soldiers, Troy

- Explore the historical sites in the old city, such as Hadrian's Gate and the Antalya Museum, showcasing artifacts from the region's rich past.


- Enjoy the Mediterranean ambiance along the picturesque Old Harbor.
